2. Research and Education area:

Analysis

The Graduate School of Science is seeking a young mathematician as a tenure-track assistant professor (in principle as a tenure-track faculty provided by Chiba University Tenure-track System). We are seeking applicants with significant achievements and expertise in research fields of Analysis.

The appointee will be engaged in education and research in graduate and undergraduate courses, including general education at Chiba University.

3. Starting Date:

February 1, 2017

4. Qualifications:

Ph.D. degree (or an equivalent degree) at the time of appointment is required.

It is also required that applicants are at age 34 years or younger as of March 31, 2017. (Note: This employment is funded by the grant for promoting enhancement of the National University Reform and aims to accelerate recruitment of young researchers pursuant to Article 1-3, paragraph 1 of the Ordinance for Enforcement of the Employment Measures Act.)

Applicants should be highly qualified in the research area specified above.

Commitment to teaching is also essential. Japanese language proficiency for research and educational activities, giving lectures and administrative work is required.

5. Basic salary:

Basic salary is determined in accordance with regulations of Chiba University and with consideration of qualification, work experience and achievement.

- (5) Summary of research achievements and future perspective of your research at Chiba University (about 2 pages)
- (6) Description of teaching experience and future plan of educational activities at Chiba University (about one page)

If education and research experiences are equivalent, preference will be given to female and/or non-Japanese applicants.
